Clover Kid Bonus Bucks*	\$20 in Johnson County 4-H Bonus Bucks to Johnson County Clover Kids (4-H members ages 5 – 7 years old as of December 31, 2018).
Johnson Co. 4-H Bonus Bucks*	\$40 in Johnson County 4-H Bonus Bucks to Johnson 4-H Members (ages 8 – 18 years old as of December 31, 2018).
Big Red Summer Academic Camp Scholarship	A \$100 scholarship for any Johnson County 4-H member (grades 10 th thru 12 th in Fall 2020) to attend a career exploration camp at UNL during the summer of 2020.
Johnson County 4-H Council Senior Scholarship	Pre-entry for the Johnson County 4-H Senior Scholarship that will be awarded in the Spring of 2020. Completion of a 2019 Nebraska 4-H Annual Achievement Application is a requirement for the award in addition to the completion of an application and essay.
2019 Johnson County 4-H Hard Luck Award	\$75 in Johnson County 4-H Bonus Bucks to a Johnson County 4-H member who has experienced "hard luck" during the 2019 4-H year. Applicants must include their hardship case and what they have learned from the experience in an essay (separate from their Achievement Application or Career Portfolio)

* Johnson County 4-H Bonus Bucks may be applied towards the registration cost of 4-H workshops/clinics/camps/conferences or the CWF trip. Additionally, the money can be used on purchasing 4-H supplies in the Extension Office. In order to be eligible for Bonus Bucks the 4-H member must submit a completed Nebraska 4-H Annual Achievement Application for the current year. Bonus Bucks awarded for 2019 4-H Record Books will be good for the 2020 and 2021 4-H programming years.
